


**UDHMODYA FOUNDATION** has been established by the University of Delhi, for promoting Innovation and Entrepreneurial culture, among all in general and students in particular. It is a Section-8 Company, set-up, to facilitate a culture of innovation and creativity, by encouraging entrepreneurial activities across the colleges/ Departments/Centers of the University. In compliance with the directions of University of Delhi, Satyawati College has also set up an 'Entrepreneurship Cell'. This E-cell has been a step towards achieving a sustainable startup ecosystem. The aim of the Entrepreneurship Cell is also to facilitate a culture of innovation and creativity, by encouraging entrepreneurial activities across the colleges, for involving students, teaching staff and non-teaching staff. Throughout the year, several activities were undertaken by the entrepreneurship cell and the UDMODHYA Foundation, independently, as well as partnering with other colleges and institutions. ### 26/04/2023: WORLD INTELLECTUAL
