प्रवर्तन, The BA Programme Society of Satyawati College is a society constituted through the college staff council. This society is neither a college committee nor a department, and thus, the functioning of the society is different from the above two. The society caters the interest of students in general and BA Programme students in particular through variety of intellectual activities (like seminars, talks, discussions, competitions), cultural events/programmes (Dance, singing and other cultural programmes).

The functioning of the society includes 'Teacher Representatives' (one convenor and other members) and few BA Programme 'Student Representatives/ office bearers' (as required). The student representatives are selected through a presentation/interview (or both) by the teacher representatives at starting of July session. This process is notified accordingly and only BA Programme students of Satyawati College (all years) can participate for the said.

Few glimpses of programmes/activities/competitions organised from July 2024 onwards are following:

First of all, the Society started with a *drive for recruitment of student representatives/ office bearers* from first, second and third year through a process of presentation and interview.

After selection of student representatives, the first activity organised was an 'Essay Writing Competition' on the topic 'The role of youth in the making of Bharat' on 8th October 2024. More than one hundred and twenty (120) students registered and eighty-three (83) turned up for the competition.

On 15th October 2024, following the Bhartiya Gyan Parampara, the Society organised Fresher's Welcome which started with a *National Seminar on 'The Role of Youth in Making of Bharat'* in the college auditorium. Shri Ajit Kumar (Centre for Policy Research), Shri R. N. Sharma (Director, NCT of Delhi), Prof Balram Pani, Chairperson Prof. Pamela Singla, Prof. Anju Seth and Prof. Subhash Singh (Principal, Satyawati Evening) graced the Seminar. After the seminar students started their *'Fresher Welcome 2024-25*, for first semester students of BA Programme. It was a successful event with students participating in dance, singing, poetry etc. On 29th March 2025, the Society organised an *'Inter-College Dance Competition'* in the Satya Auditorium. The student group from Institute of home economics won the first prize, Motilal Nehru College second and AGDIPS College third.

The Society also Organized an event on 15 April 2025, namely **'EXTEMPORE' a speech competition** for Satyawati College students. Towards the closure of the semester an 'Annual Day cum Farewell Party' was organised for BA Programme students on 5th May 2025 in the Satya Auditorium.
